15 proposals of NBFCs, HFCs get govt clearance

Finance ministry sanctioned plans worth ₹6,400 cr as part of the 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' package

THE FINANCE MINISTRY on Saturday said 15 proposals worth ₹6,399 crore of stressed NBFCs and HFCs have been sanctioned under the special liquidity scheme announced as part of the ₹20.97-lakh crore 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' package.

The scheme launched on July 1 permits both primary and secondary market purchases of debt and seeks to address the short-term liquidity issues of non-banking financial companies (NBFCs) and housing finance companies (HFCs).

"The Special Liquidity Scheme (SLS) of ₹30,000 crore was announced as a part of the #AatmanirbharBharat package with an aim to improve the liquidity position of NBFCs and HFCs," finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman said in a tweet. Sharing implementation status update of the scheme, she said, 15 proposals with a total sanc-

tioned amount of ₹6,399 crore have been cleared as on August 7 while 37 more applications, seeking financing of up to ₹11,037 crore, are under process. NBFCs and HFCs came under stress following a series of defaults by IL&FS group firms in September 2018.

Any NBFC including micro-finance institutions registered with RBI under the RBI Act, 1934 (excluding those registered as Core Investment Companies) and any HFC registered with the National Housing Bank under the National Housing Bank Act, 1987, which is complying with certain specified conditions, are eligible to raise funding from this facility.

The Reserve Bank of India has provided funds for the scheme by subscribing to government-guaranteed special

securities issued by a trust set up by SBI Capital Markets (SBI-CAP). The scheme is being implemented by SLS Trust, the SPV set up by SBICAP.

The special liquidity scheme is open for three months for making subscriptions by the Trust.

Under the scheme, the government will provide an unconditional and irrevocable guarantee to the special securities issued by the Trust.

The instruments will be commercial papers and non-convertible debentures with a residual maturity of not more than three months and rated as investment grade. Therefore, those market participants who are looking to exit their standard investments with a residual maturity of 90 days may also approach the SLS Trust.

Team India kit sponsorship: Puma buys bid document

GERMAN SPORTS APPAREL and footwear major Puma could be the front runner in bagging the Indian cricket team's kit sponsorship rights while rival Adidas could also enter the fray.

However, it couldn't be confirmed whether Nike would re-bid after refusing BCCI's scaled down bid offer from ₹370 crore (plus 30 crore royalty), which they paid from 2016 to 2020.

"I can confirm you that Puma has bought the ITT (Invitation to Tender) document worth ₹1 lakh. While buying bid document doesn't mean one is bidding, Puma has shown genuine interest in submitting a bid," a senior BCCI official told PTI on conditions of anonymity.

It is learnt that Adidas, too, has shown interest but whether it will be bidding for the sponsorship rights is still not known. Even though some feel that the German giant could independently bid for merchandise products, which will be a separate tender.

Selling of exclusive merchandise products depends on how many exclusive stores a company has along with the point of sales (shops that sell your company's products).

make these two companies the most sought after. A senior industry insider explained the whole sponsorship issue in these turbulent economic times. "Don't be surprised if you see a scaled down offer which they declined. This could mean two things. Either they are not interested or may submit a bid which is even more scaled down than what BCCI offered," he said.

As far as Puma is concerned, it has had an increased interest in the Indian market over the years especially through IPL but now it also has India captain Virat Kohli as its brand ambassador along with KL Rahul.

"Puma has been a part of IPL for some years now and with Virat in their roster, it would only enhance their presence in Indian market," he added.

Assam Baghjan well fire: NGT rejects OIL objections

THE NATIONAL GREEN Tribunal has rejected the objections raised by Oil India to a preliminary report filed by a committee on the fire incident at Baghjan well number 5 in Assam.

Oil India had raised doubts over the findings of the committee headed by former high court judge B P Katakay saying it's report was based on desk research and secondary data which needs to be verified.

A bench headed by NGT chairperson Justice A K Goel agreed with the finding of the committee, which has made three categories of persons entitled to interim compensation.

The committee has made three categories — houses completely gutted by fire, whose houses have been severely damaged and those have been moderately/partially damaged or whose standing crops and horticulture have been partially damaged. The scale of interim compensation has been fixed as ₹25 lakh, ₹10 lakh and ₹2.5 lakh, respectively. According to OIL, a compensation of ₹20 lakh has already been paid to persons covered under the first category while other two categories have not been identified. Additional compensation for the first category is also not justified, OIL said.

Gadkari bats for social micro-finance institutions

MINISTER FOR ROAD transport & highways and MSMEs Nitin Gadkari on Saturday said 'social micro-finance institutions' would help create two crore employment opportunities in the country.

Addressing CII's India@75 summit, the minister said that these institutions, where government will have no control, would function with proper licence from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).

license to these institutions on easier terms and without much paper work. These institutions will provide finance up to ₹10 lakh to one account and would act as pro-

moting entrepreneurship. "The proposed micro-finance institutions will have potential to create two crore jobs in the country. The proposal needs approval from

the finance ministry and the union cabinet though," the minister said. These institutions will provide easy finance to small entrepreneurs and encourage entrepreneurship.

Gadkari said eradication of poverty and generation of employment remained the biggest challenges for the government at present; but at the same time, without creating employment, poverty cannot be eradicated.

He also emphasised on the need of making Indian MSMEs equipped enough that they can substitute

imports and the country become self-reliant. By technology upgradation, India can also look for new export avenues in MSME sector. This will help grow a large number of ancillary units. (ends)

The government has recently expanded the MSME umbrella and industry with investment value upto ₹50 crore and turnover upto Rs 250 crore has been covered in the new definition of MSME. Also, the manufacturing and service sectors under MSME have been brought together by giving similar definitions to both.

Earlier in the morning, the former Jammu and Kashmir Lt governor was sworn in as the Comptroller and Auditor General at Rashtrapati Bhavan.

Murmu made and subscribed to the oath of office before President Ram Nath Kovind, according to a Rashtrapati Bhavan statement.

A former bureaucrat, Murmu is a 1985-batch IAS officer of Gujarat cadre. His tenure as the new CAG will be up to November 20, 2024.

He succeeds Rajiv Mehrishi, who demitted office on Friday, the office of the CAG said in the statement.

As a constitutional functionary, the CAG is primarily

entrusted with the responsibility of auditing the accounts of the central and state governments. The CAG reports are laid before Parliament and legislatures of the states.

While being administered the oath of office and secrecy at Rashtrapati Bhavan this morning, VICE President M

Venkaiah Naidu, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman, outgoing CAG Mehrishi, were among the dignitaries present.

"After the oath ceremony, Murmu came to the CAG office, where he was welcomed by the senior officers of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department," said the official statement from his new office.

Before his appointment as the Lt Governor of Union Territory J&K, he served as joint secretary in the Department of Expenditure, additional secretary in the Department of Financial Services and Department of Revenue. Later, he served as special secretary in the Department of Expenditure before being appointed as the full-fledged secretary of the department.

And before his tenure at the Centre, Murmu served on important assignments in Gujarat.

CIL revises FY21 output target to 650-660 MT

COAL INDIA, THE world's largest coal miner, has revised its production target downwards to 650-660 million tonne (MT) for the current fiscal year against the initial production target of 710 million tonne due to Covid-related disruptions.

Coal India chairman-cum-managing director Pramod Agrawal said at least 650 to 660 million tonne of coal were expected to be produced by the end of this financial year, ensuring that coal shortage was not felt by the industry.

"Covid-19 has adversely affected demands. However, now demand is returning. We expect it will improve further," Agrawal said at an e-session organised by the Bharat Chamber of Commerce on Saturday.

Demand for coal fell nearly 16-17% during the first half of FY21 compared to the same period last financial year. In the first few days of August, the company has witnessed around 13-14% growth in demands over the same period last year. Coal offtake was expected to improve fur-

ther from September, Agrawal said.

He stressed that the progress of the Jharia Coal Project in Jharkhand for the mining of coking coal was temporarily stalled due to Covid-19 disruptions. Till July, Coal India's production and coal offtake saw de-growth of 9.7% and 18%, respectively, at 158.37 million tonne and 164.02 million tonne, respectively.

Currently, Coal India is working on offering the mineral to consumers who depend on imports in the Western and Southern regions. The company has recently introduced a special spot e-auction scheme for importers.

In contrast to apprehensions that commercial mining may hurt interests of Coal India, Agrawal said it would help introduce, "a market-linked price mechanism" and this would only benefit the state-run coal miner as its 'regulated' price would be far cheaper.

On the coal quality issues, he stated that the third-party coal quality assessment system had to be reformed and, in this regard, efficient international quality control consultants would be hired for more credible results.

Bengal's logistics policy ready, says Mitra

WESTBENGAL FINANCE minister Amit Mitra said on Saturday the state was ready with a logistics policy and would soon seek feedback from the industry.

Speaking at a webinar organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), he said the policy would try to integrate the fragmented logistics sector of the state and also drive in efficiency. "The policy on the logistics sector is ready and we will seek inputs from the industry. The logistics sector is very important since it creates huge employment opportunities," Mitra said.

The policy will broadly deal with areas like creating last-mile connectivity, fostering technology adoption and building logistics skill sets, he added.

West Bengal is uniquely poised in its positioning as it has the advantage of multimodal logistics capabilities such as



water, roads and railways, Mitra said. The size of the state's logistics market is \$20 billion, which makes it an attractive proposition for businesses, he said.

The consumer base in Kolkata alone is 14 million, the minister said. He said the government was promoting logistics hubs in Siliguri, Malda, Tajpur and Durgapur. Some of the focus sectors are tea, chemicals and petrochemicals, food processing, renewable energy and jute products. The state is also part of international corridors like BBIN, BCIM and BIM-STECS, he said.

Will take corrective action after receiving plane crash probe report: AAI chief

THE AIRPORTS AUTHORITY of India (AAI) chairman Arvind Singh on Saturday said "corrective action" would be taken after receiving the probe report on the Air India Express plane crash at Kozhikode airport on Friday.

The airport in Kerala, which has a tabletop runway, is operated by state-owned AAI.

Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) is probing the accident at the Kozhikode airport that has left at least 18 people dead, including the two pilots of the plane. The Digital Flight Data Recorder (DFDR) and the Cockpit Voice Recorder (CVR) have been recovered at the crash site. Singh said rescue work was over and reasons for the crash would be known once the AAIB report comes.

"This report will tell us about all the issues... we are awaiting the inquiry report and then we will take corrective action," he told PTI. On whether there were any safety issues had come to the notice of the AAI in recent times, Singh replied in the negative.

He noted that prior to Covid-19, there were around 70 departures as well as 70 arrivals at

जापान के फंसे जहाज से कई टन ईंधन रिसाव के बाद

मॉरीशस में ‘पर्यावरणीय आपातकाल’ घोषित

जोहानिसबर्ग, 8 अगस्त (एपी)।

मॉरीशस ने तट पर फंसे जापान के स्वामित्व वाले एक जहाज से कई टन ईंधन के रिसाव शुरू होने के बाद शुक्रवार देर रात ‘पर्यावरणीय आपातकाल की स्थिति’ घोषित कर दी।

प्रधानमंत्री प्रविंद जगन्नाथ ने इसकी घोषणा तब की जब उपग्रह से ली गई तस्वीरों में उन पर्यावरणीय इलाकों के पास नीले जल में गहरे रंग का तैलीय पदार्थ फैलाता दिखा जिन्हें सरकार ने ‘बेहद संवेदनशील’ बताया। मॉरीशस ने कहा कि यह पोत करीब 4,000 टन ईंधन ले जा रहा था और इसके निचले हिस्से में दरारें आ गई हैं।

जगन्नाथ ने इससे पहले दोपहर में कहा था कि उनकी सरकार मदद के लिए फ्रांस से अपील कर रही है। उन्होंने साथ ही कहा था कि यह रिसाव 13 लाख की आबादी वाले उनके देश के लिए ‘एक खतरा’ है जो मुख्यतः पर्यटन पर आश्रित है और कोरोना वैश्विक महामारी के प्रभावों से बुरी तरह प्रभावित है। उन्होंने कहा कि हमारे देश के पास फंसे हुए पोतों को फिर से प्रवाहमान बनाने का कौशल और विशेषज्ञता हासिल नहीं है, इसलिए मैंने फ्रांस और

कैप्टन मोहम्मद हुसैन ने बताया कि मृतकों की संख्या बढ़ने की आशंका है। पुलिस कर्नल अहमद मूसे ने कहा कि हमलावर ने चारटा-नबड्डा जिले में 12 अप्रैल आर्मी ब्रिगेड अड्डे पर हमला किया।

इसके साथ ही प्रत्यक्षदर्शियों ने कहा कि पुलिस ने वहां घेराबंदी कर दी और एंबुलेंस के सायरन सुने गए। वहां से धुएं का गुब्बारा निकलता देखा गया। साथ ही अल-कायदा से जुड़ा अल-शाबाब चरमपंथी समूह मोगादिशु में अक्सर सैन्य ठिकानों को निशाना बनाता है।

विश्व बैंक ने भारत और पाकिस्तान के बीच लंबे समय से लंबित जल विवाद के समाधान के लिए एक निष्पक्ष विशेषज्ञ या मध्यस्थता अदालत (सीओए) नियुक्त करने पर स्वतंत्र फैसला लेने में सक्षम नहीं होने की बात कही है। यहां मीडिया में आई एक खबर में यह कहा गया है। खबर के मुताबिक विश्व बैंक ने यह भी कहा कि दोनों देशों को द्विपक्षीय तरीके से एक विकल्प चुनना चाहिए।

बताते चलें कि भारत और पाकिस्तान ने नौ साल की लंबी बातचीत के बाद 1960 में एक संधि पर हस्ताक्षर किए थे। इसमें वाणिज्योत्तन स्थित विश्व बैंक भी एक हस्ताक्षरकर्ता था। यह संधि नदियों के जल के उपयोग के बारे में दोनों देशों के बीच सहयोग और सूचना के आदान-प्रदान के लिए एक तंत्र का प्रावधान करती है।

विषाणुनाशक रसायन के सेवन से अमेरिका में चार लोगों की मौत

न्यूयॉर्क, 8 अगस्त (एपी)।

अल्कोहल युक्त विषाणुनाशक रसायन (सैनेटाइजर) कोरोना को फैलने से रोकने में मददगार साबित हो सकता है लेकिन ऐसे उत्पादों को पी लेना दो राज्य के चार लोगों के लिए जानलेवा साबित हो गया।

स्वास्थ्य अधिकारियों ने इस हफ्ते जानकारी दी कि मई और जून में विषाणुनाशक रसायन पी लेने से एरिजोना और न्यू मैक्सिको में 15 वयस्कों के शरीर में जहर फैल गया। रोग नियंत्रण एवं बचाव केंद्र ने बताया कि इनमें से चार लोगों की मौत हो गई जबकि तीन अन्य को दृष्टि संबंधी समस्या का सामना करना पड़ रहा है।

उन सभी ने उन विषाणुनाशक रसायनों का सेवन किया था जिसमें मैथेनॉल या युड अल्कोहल था। वैद्य विषाणुनाशक रसायनों में कीटनाशक पर जहरीले मैथेनॉल का प्रयोग कर रही हैं जो एंटीबैज (किसी द्रव का जमाव बिंदु कम करने के लिए इस्तेमाल होने वाला योग्य) में इस्तेमाल होता है।

सऊदी अरब ने पाकिस्तान को उधार पर तेल की आपूर्ति रोकी

पाकिस्तान को सऊदी अरब से उधार पर कच्चा तेल मई से नहीं मिला है। साथ ही उसे आपूर्तिकर्ता की ओर से इस सुविधा को जारी रखने के बारे में अभी कोई जवाब भी नहीं मिला है।

रपटों के मुताबिक दोनों पक्षों के बीच इस बाबत 3.2 अरब डॉलर के समझौते की मियाद दो महीने पहले ही समाप्त हो चुकी है। ‘द एक्सप्रेस ट्रिब्यून’ में शुक्रवार को प्रकाशित रिपोर्ट के अनुसार सऊदी अरब ने नवंबर, 2018 में पाकिस्तान की बाहरी क्षेत्र की पिता को दूर करने के लिए 6.2 अरब डॉलर के पैकेज की घोषणा की थी। सऊदी अरब से 3.2 अरब डॉलर की कच्चे तेल की सुविधा इसी पैकेज का हिस्सा है। पाकिस्तान ने सऊदी अरब से इस व्यवस्था के विस्तार का आग्रह किया है, लेकिन अभी तक उसे इस पर जवाब नहीं मिला है।

मई में समाप्त हो गया। वित्त विभाग इसके नवीकरण का प्रयास कर रहा है। उन्होंने कहा कि पाकिस्तान को सऊदी अरब सरकार से जवाब का इंतजार है। यह घटनाक्रम ऐसे समय हुआ है जबकि उसका अंतरराष्ट्रीय मुद्राकोष (आइएमएफ) कार्यक्रम भी पिछले पांच माह से तकनीकी तौर पर स्थगित है।

रिपोर्ट में कहा गया है कि सऊदी ऋण को वापस करने और तेल सुविधा की मियाद समाप्त होने से केंद्रीय बैंक के आधिकारिक मुद्रा भंडार पर बचाव बढ़ सकता है। यह भंडार शुद्ध रूप से कर्ज लेकर बनाया गया है। बजट अनुमानों के अनुसार सरकार को वित्त वर्ष 2020-21 में न्यूनतम एक अरब डॉलर का कच्चा तेल मिलने की उम्मीद है। पाकिस्तान का वित्त वर्ष जुलाई से शुरू होता है। रिपोर्ट में कहा गया है कि पाकिस्तान ने समय से चार महीने पहले एक अरब डॉलर का सऊदी अरब का ऋण चुका दिया है। सऊदी के हवाले से कहा गया है कि यदि पाकिस्तान को चीन से इसी तरह की सुविधा मिलती

है तो वह दो अरब डॉलर का नकद ऋण भी लौटाने की स्थिति में होगा।
